Griffin LLP, says lawyers must tread carefully when they get
into the merits of a proposed class action, even as early as
certification, as parties try to get as much information as
possible.

That’s especially the case with expert witnesses, since
Canadian procedure doesn’t usually have discovery of expert
witnesses in advance of trial.

“It was just a disproportionate request to what was being
asked,” Jilesen says, who was not involved in the case.
